The Defense Media Activity (DMA) is seeking information from industry to assist with the development and planning of a potential new requirement. The intent of this **Sources Sought** is to gain information on the agency's requirement for a Department of Defense (War) Public Website Program and Services to implement the requirements of 21st Century Integrated Digital Experience Act (IDEA), Public Law 115-336, as well as the innovation, technological advances, and design initiatives of Executive Order 14338, *Improving Our Nation Through Better Design*. Responses provided may be used by DMA to assist in budgetary planning, the development of an acquisition strategy, Performance Work Statement, salient characteristics, and performance specifications. Interested parties are responsible for adequately marking proprietary or competition sensitive information contained in their response.

Specific support is required to ascertain industry's ability to furnish a turnkey solution for public-facing websites to operate in a DoD Joint Warfighting Cloud Capability commercial cloud service. The solution shall comprise of components that meet the required capabilities detailed later in this document. Vendors are encouraged to provide as much information as possible regarding their proven experience in developing these capabilities.

DMA representatives may choose to meet with respondents and others who express interest and hold oneon-one discussions. Such discussions would only be intended to obtain further clarification of potential capability to meet the requirements, including any development and implementation risks.

The Government reserves the right to use information provided by respondents for any purpose deemed necessary and legally appropriate. Any organization responding to this notice should ensure that its response is complete and sufficiently detailed. Information provided will be used to assess availability of the anticipated requirement and may lead to the development of a solicitation. Respondents are advised that the Government is under no obligation to provide feedback to respondents with respect to any information submitted.

Purpose

This SOURCES SOUGHT. The Defense Media Activity outlines the Government's requirement for the for the procurement of professional services, and commodities outlined in the scope to support all the DoD Public Web Program and our customers. Interested parties are responsible for adequately marking proprietary or competition sensitive information contained in their response. Respondents are advised that the Government is under no obligation to provide feedback to respondents with respect to any information submitted.

Scope

The Defense Media Activity (DMA) requires a turnkey web application software (design, content management, applications) that will operate in one of the DoD approved commercial cloud service provider (CCSP) within the DoD Joint Warfighting Cloud Capability (JWCC) that is accessible by any public person. The software is required to comply with the 21st Century Integrated Digital Experience Act (IDEA), Public Law 115-336 specifically section 508 of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). Additionally, the solution must support the United States Web Design System (USWDS) [and any updates to the USWDS]. The software must operate with the DoW Digital Asset Management System (DAMS) to provide video playbook through the website as well as upload digital assets (for all photos and videos) from the proposed web content management system (CMS) to the DAMS. The proposed services will conform to the DoD's Cloud Computing Security Requirements Guide, as well as meet all DoD Risk Management Framework (RMF) requirements and provide website administrators and content managers authenticated access per DoD requirements. DMA is not seeking information on digital services as defined in the 21st Century IDEA.

Creation and Design

The software must provide tools that help government administrators and content managers easily build visual structures and user-friendly interface of the website that meet the USWDS requirements. The tools must require minimal training. DMA expects the software tools to provide templates or easily created templates that offer minimal work on behalf of the administrators and content managers. DMA expects the software to have drag and drop features and artificial intelligence (AI) that streamlines and eases the burden on the content managers who need to update information, photos and videos in a very expeditious manner.

Content Management System (CMS)

The CMS must also be user friendly for content managers to organize and update text, images, and other media with simplistic interfaces. The CMS must also work with the DoD DAMS [currently the Defense Visual Information Distribution Service] using Application Programming Interfaces (APIs) for photographic display and video playback through the DoD public websites. The CMS must also work with APIs for photographic and video upload to the DAMS, thereby reducing redundant work on behalf

of the content managers.

User Interaction

The applications must provide dynamic user experience meeting the requirements of the 21st Century IDEA and be extremely mobile friendly. The applications will meet the requirements of Section 508 or the American Disabilities Act (ADA) for websites.

Training and Knowledge Base Repository

The contractor will provide training for the government administrators and content managers. The contractor will provide a knowledge base platform that is easily accessible from anywhere in the world to serve as a centralized digital repository for information, such as FAQs, product documentation, troubleshooting guides and how-to articles. The repository must be user friendly where solutions can be found on demand. The repository should have materials available to ensure users and integrated AI for getting answers to questions instantly.

Migration Operations

DMA may require content migration from the current system to the Contractor proposed solution. The Contractor may be required to provide migration, migration planning, site structure and taxonomy solutions, execution, and follow up to ensure complete and effective website migrations on Government request. The Contractor shall have migration specialists with a high level of knowledge on the CMS and all associated applications.

Cybersecurity Requirements

The contractor shall perform aspects of the DoD Risk Management Framework for DoD Systems as applied to the web application software to operate in an approved DoD Cloud Service Provider environment (i.e., Amazon Web Services, Oracle, Microsoft Azure, Google). These requirements are defined in DoD Instruction 8510.01 at https://www.esd.whs.mil/Directives/issuances/dodi/. The contractor shall implement a zero trust architecture with the proposed web services, including identity verification, network segmentation, and access control. The contractor shall ensure capabilities for detecting, responding to, and reporting on cyber security threats are implemented, as well as safeguard data at rest and in transit for the implemented solution.
